In the Edgehill benefice we offer:

1. Live stream services on [Facebook](#) and [YouTube](#) at 10.30 every Sunday. These can be accessed:

2. Midweek communion service on Zoom* at 9.30am on a Thursday morning
3. Night prayer on weekdays at 9pm on our [Facebook livestream](#). This prayer follows the contemplative tradition and helps us to reflect on how we have encountered God in that day

As well as the online services we will continue to offer a couple of touching points for conversation in the week:

1. We offer a virtual coffee morning on Zoom* between 10 and 11 on a Thursday morning
2. We offer a chance to catch up with each other after the 10.30 service on Zoom* on a Sunday

2. The **DailyHope** phone line is a free national telephone line, offers music, prayers and reflections as well as full worship services from the Church of England at the end of the phone. The line – which is available 24 hours a day on **0800 804 8044** – has been set up particularly with those unable to join online church services during the period of restrictions in mind; to provide comfort and spiritual nourishment to the most isolated in our society.
