Combroke Flood Risk Management Group (Tim, Hugh and Jim) have mapped every road gulley, ditch and inspection chamber. The team have also cleared the gulley by the bridge.

WCC have jetted the blocked gulleys and pipes; those that remain blocked are being investigated using camera surveys.

The silt trap outside number 14 was partly filled with concrete; the concrete has now been removed. Waiting for the flood management team to advise on what further actions they and the County Highways team intend to take.
